NIH Grant Funds Installation of Clinical Quality Management System in Michigan Health Clinics

Cielo MedSolutions donates software system to Care Free Medical & Dental

ANN ARBOR, MI – July 25, 2007 – Healthcare information technology (IT) company Cielo MedSolutions announces its clinical quality management system, Cielo Clinic™, will be installed in Care Free Medical & Dental’s Lansing and Mason clinics.

Care Free Medical & Dental will use the Cielo Clinic system for quality improvement via clinical reminders the system provides. The clinics will also use the medical software system for an observational study of depression symptoms in patients with coronary heart disease.

The NIH awarded the grant to a collaborative effort between the University of Michigan’s Center for the Advancement of Clinical Research (CACR) and GRIN – the Great Lakes Research Into Practice Network.
